



Dear Parent

We would like to thank you for taking the time to complete this application. As a school we appreciate the fact that deciding on a school for your child's education is not a decision taken lightly.

Stulting Primary School has a proud legacy of providing over 70 years of educational excellence and a rich history of being one of the corner-stones of our community. We strive to provide our children with a quality and holistic education and this goal is only achievable when there is a partnership between the school and the parents.

Before applying to our school, kindly consider the following important aspects:

- Subject to the South African Schools Act (SASA) Section 5 (5) and applicable provincial law, the admission policy of Stulting Primary School is determined by the school's Governing Body.
- If you complete this application form and the application proves to be successful, you have entered into a legal agreement with the school, so we urge you to read the application form carefully.
- We are a fee-paying school. The Department of Education contributes minimally to our school's budget and we are thus dependent on payment of school fees. Without these funds we would not be able to provide the standard of education we have become known for.
- Please take the financial implications into account when you decide to enrol your child at Stulting Primary School. This is a long term investment in your child's future where you will be expected to pay school fees up front.
- Your child will be expected to wear a school uniform, do homework and participate in extra-mural activities. This will bring on other personal commitments and financial obligations towards school tours and sport clothing. As a parent you will also be expected to attend parent teacher meetings and assist the school during fund-raising events.
- We urge you to also apply at other schools as we are unable to accommodate all applicants. The decision of the application committee is final and no interviews for admission will be given thereafter.
- If your application proves to be unsuccessful, the parent may appeal this decision of the Governing Body by registering your complaint directly to the offices of the MEC, not to the Department of Education or the Uitenhage District Office (*SASA Section 5(9)*).
- A copy of the admission policy & code of conduct is available at the school office.
- Learners must be fluent in one or both languages of instruction (*i.e. English/Afrikaans*).

Because your child has a right to basic education, the government has made other schools in our area available that provide free education. They are fully funded by the Department of Education and also provide a quality education, subject to the same curriculum and standards set by the Department.

We have a committed team of educators striving for educational excellence and we are proud to serve the Humansdorp community.
